

THINK AGAIN before you drive off without securing your battery. During hard braking or cornering, your battery can tip over and short out on nearby parts and sheet metal - igniting fumes or burning through the paint on your hood (as has happened on TR-3's).

Blaine's is located just south of Pearl in Plain, and their telephone number is 939-1935.



Check Your Pulleys

Ever have a water pump lose a seal before? What a mess! Especially when it occurs twice in the first 300 miles since your restoration!

The problem was traced to a bad pulley, an unusual occurance, I thought. As it turned out, this condition also took out the pulley on the dynamo and shook loose the lower dynamo mounting bolt.

The next time you have either of these pulleys off, do yourself a favor and check for wear as illustrated below (tightening the shaft nut is only a very temporary fix). There is a good chance that you will not even be able to remove the pulley if the wear occurred as illustrated!



British Car Trophies

Two new awards were created for the Asphalt Jungle II Autocross sponsored by Foriegn Car Parts Warehouse and administered by the Miss. Region SCCA. The awards were for the fastest British cars in both stock and modified categories.

Approximately 38 cars competed in the March 4 event with 6 MG's entered. The fastest British stock car was the MGB-GT entered by Cris Schooler, son of Roy and Penny Schooler, in his very first autocross. The fastest British modified car was an MGB driven by David Toney.

Where were the Triumphs? Absent from competition was the Moore Spitfire and the Brunson GT-6. Both cars are virtually unbeatable in their classes and often receive FTD's.
