A beginners leading workshop will be held at the Wade's home in Brandon on Saturday, August 29, beginning at 1:00 pm.

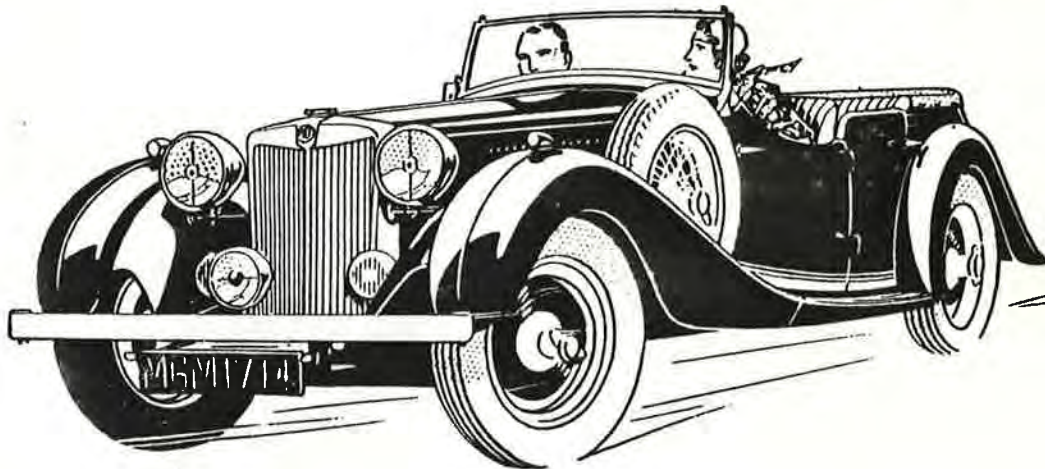
This workshop will show you the fundamentals of surface preparation, the application of lead filler, and finishing techniques. If all goes well, each participant will have a chance at trying the technique.

I suppose, like many

of us car fanatics, I've tried dozens of waxes, compounds, resins, and glazes over the years to try and protect my car's paint while providing an easy-to-apply and long-lasting deep shine. Some worked for me better than others, but I hadn't found that "perfect" combination of wax-like properties such as hardness, luster, and ease of use . . . maybe I just found one! A distributor outfit from Bakersfield, California called "The Wax Shop" markets a full line of car care products and has been around for 30 years. What I tried was their "Dark Magic" cream compound (\$9.50/16 oz) followed by their

carnuba wax based "Super Glaze" (\$8.50/16 oz). Following instructions to the letter, I buffed out our black laquered Pontiac with DM then applied the SG and buffed again (SG is carnuba dissolved in a mineral spirits-like solvent, so it stays on 10 plus minutes to allow complete evaporation of the solvent). What I got was a mirror-like hard coating that appears to resist dulling and deterioration! This stuff can't build up or yellow, and I LIKE IT! If you're interested, I know of one distributor in these parts - Bennett Distribution (601-774-8253 days, 601-774-8309 nights).

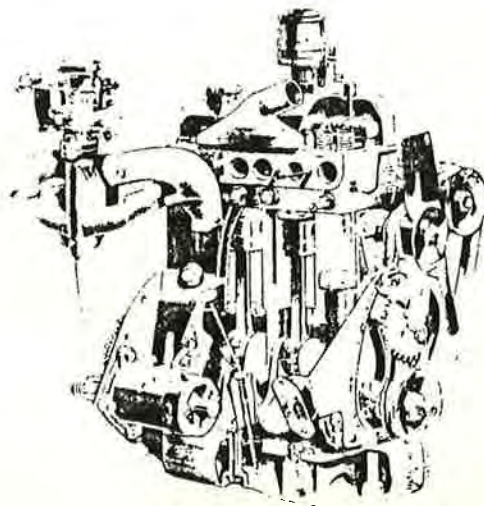

Your editor would like to remind everyone that this newsletter needs your help by submitting your articles and tech tips for publication.

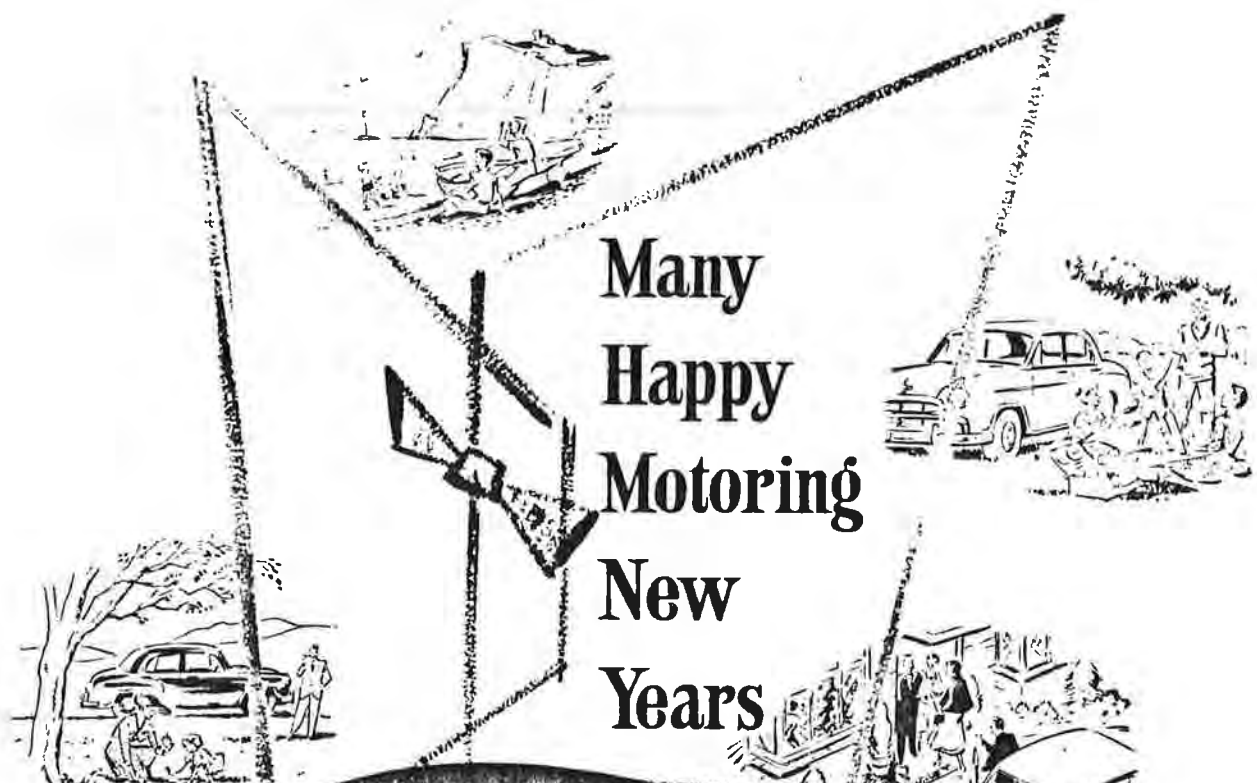

A special thanks to all of you who have submitted material to us over the past five years - it's awfully difficult for one person to write, arrange, type and publish this newsletter.

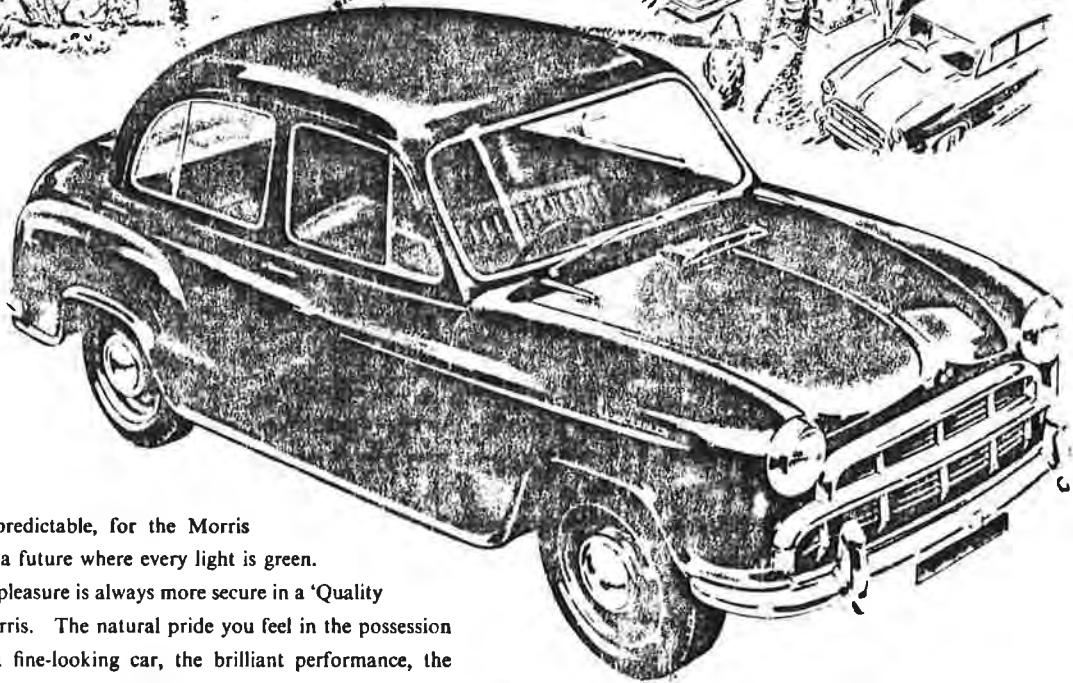
