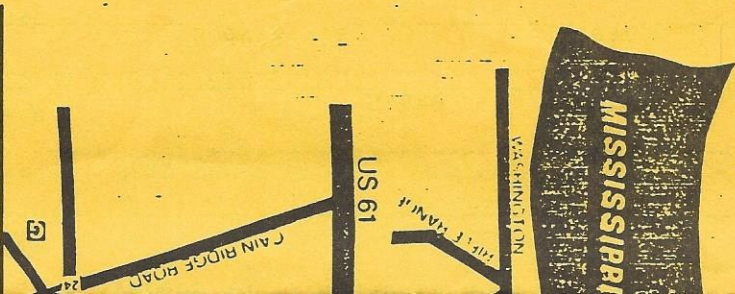
The Rally will be a Hare and Hound Rally in the Scenic Environs of Vicksburg

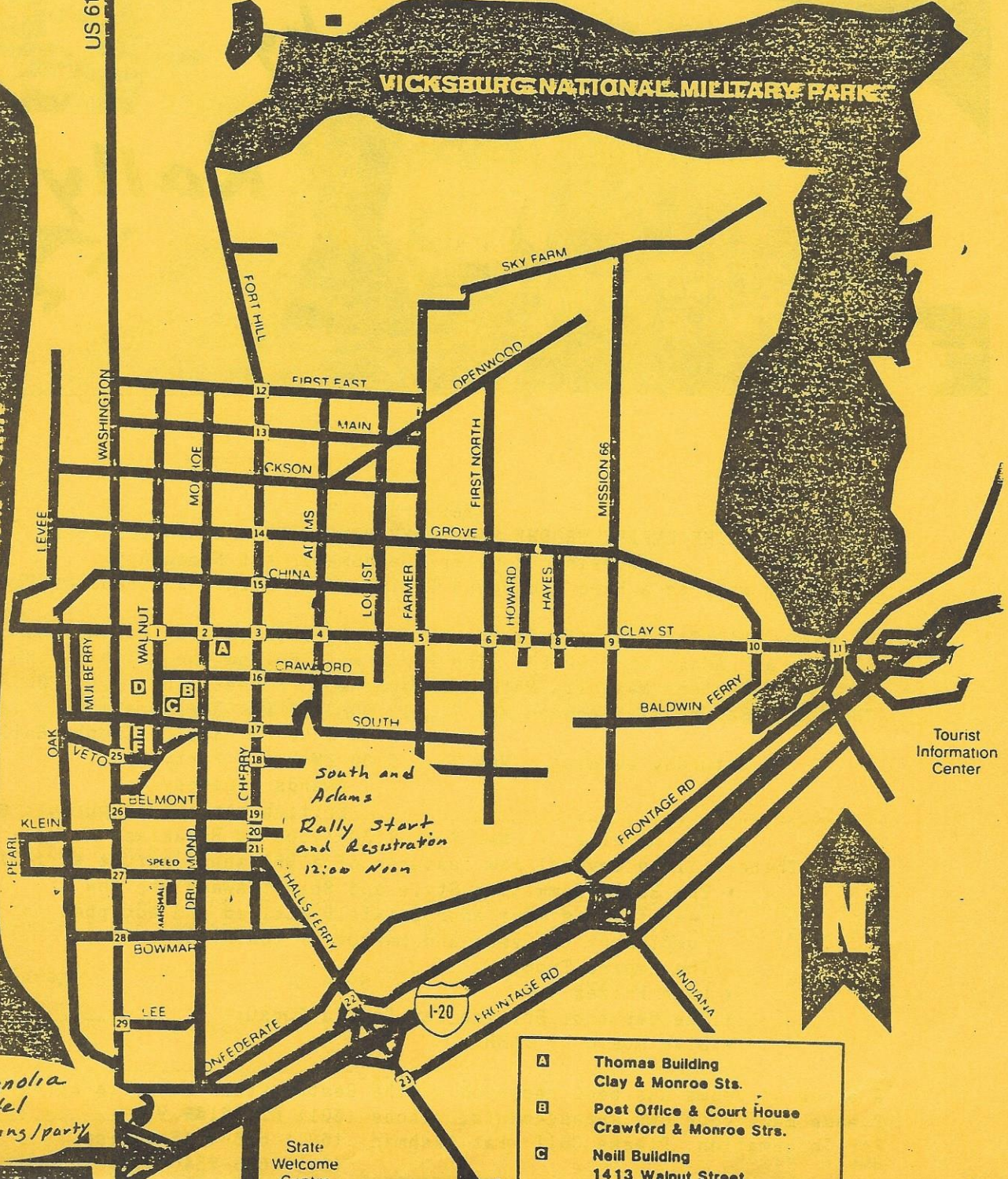
