

British Car Day

The Central Mississippi Chapter of the Vintage Triumph Register will sponsor its third annual British Car Day at the Jackson Zoo on Saturday, September 28, from 10 am to 4 pm.

The event will take place in the open field directly behind the Livingston Park Community Club House.

Jackson's Vintage Triumph Register has been in existence since 1981 and caters to the owners of older British sports cars by providing parts assistance, technical advice, monthly newsletters, and special outings. Although this non-profit club specializes in Triumphs, the club services have also attracted a number of members who own Jaguars, Austin Healeys and MG's.

The British Car Day is the club's

biggest annual event. By sponsoring British car-related contests, the club has drawn participants from throughout Mississippi and surrounding states. Contests this year will include Concours and "Round Tuit" classes for each British car marque, a British car trivia contest, a fan belt toss, and a "What Is It" parts contest. Although there will be a small registration fee for those who wish to register their British cars for the event, there will be no admission charge to the general public. All profits will be turned over to the Jackson Zoo.

Scoring


- 12-10: You're spending too much time watching old movies. Get out there and work on your car.




